F6		Switches between the worksheet, Ribbon, task pane, and Zoom controls. In a worksheet that has been split (View menu, Manage This Window, Freeze Panes, Split Window command), F6 includes the split panes when switching between panes and the Ribbon area.
Ctrl + F6	Cmd + ~	Switches to the next workbook window when more than one workbook window is open
Shift + F6		Switches between the worksheet, Zoom controls, task pane, and Ribbon
F7	F7	Displays the Spell Check dialogue box
Ctrl + F7		Performs the Move command on the workbook window when it is not maximized. Use the arrow keys to move the window, and when finished press ENTER or ESC to cancel
F8	F8	Turns extend mode on or off. In extend mode, Extended Selection appears in the status line, and the arrow keys extend the selection.
Alt + F8	Option + F8	Displays the Macro dialogue box to create, run, edit, or delete a macro
Ctrl + F8		Performs the Size command (on the Control menu for the workbook window) when a workbook is not maximized
Shift + F8	Shift + F8	Enables you to add a nonadjacent cell or range to a selection of cells by using the arrow keys
F9	F9 Cmd + =	Calculates all worksheets in all open workbooks
Ctrl + F9	Ctrl + F9	Minimizes a workbook window to an icon
Shift + F9	Shift + F9	Calculates the active sheet
Ctrl + Alt + Shift + F9		Rechecks dependent formulas, and then calculates all cells in all open workbooks, including cells not marked as needing to be calculated
Ctrl + Alt + F9		Calculates all worksheets in all open workbooks, regardless of whether they have changed since the last calculation

Home	Home Fn + Left Arrow	Moves to the beginning of a row in a worksheet. Moves to the cell in the upper-left corner of the window when SCROLL LOCK is turned on. Selects the first command on the menu when a menu or submenu is visible

Alt + Spacebar Spacebar		Displays the Control menu for the Microsoft Office Excel window In a dialogue box, performs the action for the selected button, or selects or clears a checkbox
Shift + Tab	Shift + Tab	Moves to the previous cell in a worksheet or the previous option in a dialogue box
Ctrl + Tab		Switches to the next tab in the dialogue box
Ctrl + Shift + Tab		Switches to the previous tab in a dialogue box
Tab	Tab	Moves one cell to the right in a worksheet. Moves between unlocked cells in a protected worksheet. Moves to the next option or option group in a dialogue box.
Arrow Keys	Arrow Keys	Move one cell up, down, left, or right in a worksheet.
